

## 20th Anniversary of the UCSF Cardiology Council

Jeff Olgin and Division of Cardiology hosted 112 donors on March 19th at the St. Francis Yacht Club to celebrate the 20th anniversary of Bill Grossman's arrival at UCSF and the founding of the Cardiology Council.

Soon after Dr. Grossman's arrival at UCSF in 1997, philanthropist Danielle Walker invited him to her home to meet patients and friends of the UCSF Division of Cardiology. Inspired by Dr. Grossman's vision and committed to UCSF, Mrs. Walker and her guests founded the Cardiology Council, a group of grateful patients who make unrestricted annual gifts to the Division of Cardiology. The Council now includes more than 300 families who support cardiology research, education and clinical care.

Dr. Grossman, who holds the Charles and Helen Schwab Endowed Chair in Preventive Cardiology, continues to focus on patient care and leads the UCSF Center for Prevention of Heart and Vascular Disease at Mission Bay.
