Greg Buller is a graduate of the University of Kansas School of Medicine and completed both his residency in medicine and fellowship in nephrology at Duke University. After completing his fellowship, Dr. Buller joined Yale University as an assistant professor. He currently holds the position of Clinical Professor of Medicine at Yale. During his time on the faculty, Dr. Buller has held several leadership positions including Chair of Medicine at Yale New Haven Health-Bridgeport since 2014. Dr. Buller has served on the IRB, was residency program director for 5 years and DIO for 5 years all at St. Mary's Hospital. Dr. Buller is the recipient of multiple teaching awards and has given multiple invited regional and national lectures. He has had an active role in clinical trials mainly in hypertension and kidney disease and has published 39 articles, 15 as first author and 13 as senior author. He is also a reviewer for 6 journals including *Annals of Internal Medicine*, *ACP Journal Club* and *American Journal of Kidney Diseases*. I am looking forward to Dr. Buller's leadership in continuing to move the department of medicine forward. Please join me in welcoming him to this new role.
